Hereby agreed as follow:

1. Partnership and Objectives:

The Partnership between Emergenza Sorrison Doctors for Smiling Children and the [Redacted] is aimed at jointly act in the emergency sector and to execute projects and programs to improve the living conditions of local peoples, IDPs - Internally Displaced Peoples and Migrants. The partnership has submitted a specific project proposal to the Italian Cooperation call for proposal with deadline November 29th - AID 11273. The identified migrants' centers are: Tarek al Sika, Tarek al Matar and Tajoura, as indicated by the Italian call for Proposal.

2. Leading NGO

Emergenza Sorrison is the leading applicant as requested by the Italian cooperation guidelines and the International Cooperation Council will be the associated partner of the partnership

3. Exclusivity:

The parties agree to work together for this project during the entire duration of this agreement. Complete or partial assignment or transfer of interest or shares of orders to other parties, cannot take place without the consent of the parties.

4. Responsible persons:

Each partner will designate a responsible person for its input to the joint proposal. The Scientific Responsible of Emergenza Sorrison is Dr. [Redacted] for the [Redacted]

Any matters which do not refer exclusively to one partner, or which affect the common interest of the planned partnership, will also be decided by these representatives. Resolution shall be unanimous.

5. Services provision:

- [REDACTED] will support the activity of the project as follows:
- Identification of doctors and experts (10 doctors have been identified, it's necessary to identify other 5 doctors assuring the presence in every rotation will be a psychological expert, a gynaecological pregnancy expert in every migrants' center. One third of doctors will work in public health care structures in Tripoli to help Libyan population to have access to health care assistance, as foreseen by the project proposal. The health care structures will be identified by the [REDACTED] in accordance to the Scientific Director, [REDACTED].
 - Technical assistance to assist the project, to contact migrants centers directors and staff, to agree with them the condition on Medical Centers in the three selected migrants' centers
 - Technical assistance to the transportation of Medical Centers equipment and modules giving support to the Libyan coordinator, [REDACTED]
 - Reception of medicines to be distributed in the migrants' centers and in 20% percentage to the Libyan population through the medical service in public health care structure in Tripoli.
 - Coordination of selected doctors to be trained in Tunis in January 2018 and coordination to three Migrants' Centers directors or their delegates to participate to the training session on emergency management in Tunis in the same period (January 2018)
 - Monitor of health care assistance and collection of data to be transfer to Italy Desk to elaborate monitor and evaluation reports.
 - Monitor medicines and kits distribution
 - Weekly meeting through E-system conference call with Project Manager, Libyan Coordinator and Italy Desk to report on activities.
 - Report any weakness and strengths elements.

6. Emergenza Sorrisi will make best efforts to manage the project related costs as efficiently as possible.

7. Project Management

- 7.1 A Project Backstopping unit (PBU) is established. Emergenza Sorrisi provides the Chairperson of the PBU (Scientific Responsible, [REDACTED]), the PBU by Emergenza Sorrisi is composed by the General Project Manager, [REDACTED], Libyan Coordinator [REDACTED] and Italy Desk, Barbara Bugliosi, [REDACTED] By National Center of Disease Control, [REDACTED]
