

# ASSEGNO UNICO UNIVERSALE – AUU

## ALL-INCLUSIVE FAMILY ALLOWANCE

### What is it?

This is an **economic support** measure for families provided for **each dependent child** up to the age of 21 and without age limits for children with disabilities.

### Who is it for?



Families with **minor children**

Families with **adult children (up to 21 years) who are:**

- studying;
- in a work experience or other employment with a total income of less than € 8,000/year;
- unemployed and registered with the employment centre;
- involved in social service;

Families with **children with disabilities** (without age limit)

To receive the allowance, you must be **resident:**

1. in Italy for at least 2 years OR ALTERNATIVELY have a permanent or fixed-term employment of at least 6 months.
2. in Italy at the time of application and for the entire period during which you receive the All-Inclusive Family Allowance – AUU.

# You are definitely entitled to the allowance if

- you are an Italian or EU citizen,
- you are a family member of an Italian or EU citizen,
- you have a long-term permit (settled status),
- you have a single work permit (family, work, pending employment) authorizing employment for periods of more than 6 months,
- you have a research permit authorizing you to stay for periods of more than 6 months,
- you are under international protection or are stateless,
- you have a Blue Card,
- you have a permit for self-employment,
- you are a worker from Algeria, Morocco or Tunisia.

**If you **do not** have the required residence permit**

**Send your application anyways** by registered letter or certified email to the INPS office for your area, **specifying the type of your residence permit**

**and**

contact a Citizens Advice Bureau (patronato), trade unions or organizations such as ASGI to **learn more about your rights and evaluate the possibility of taking legal action.**
