





# ASSEGNO UNICO UNIVERSALE – AUU

## ALL-INCLUSIVE FAMILY ALLOWANCE

#### What is it?

This is an **economic support** measure for families provided for **each dependent child** up to the age of 21 and without age limits for children with disabilities.





Families with minor children

Families with adult children (up to 21 years) who are:

- studying;
- in a work experience or other employment with a total income of less than € 8,000/year;
- unemployed and registered with the employment centre;
- involved in social service;

Families with **children with disabilities** (without age limit)

To receive the allowance, you must be **resident**:

- 1. in Italy for at least 2 years OR ALTERNATIVELY have a permanent or fixed-term employment of at least 6 months.
- 2. in Italy at the time of application and for the entire period during which you receive the All-Inclusive Family Allowance AUU.

### You are definitely entitled to the allowance if

- · you are an Italian or EU citizen,
- · you are a family member of an Italian or EU citizen,
- you have a long-term permit (settled status),
- you have a single work permit (family, work, pending employment) authorizing employment for periods of more than 6 months,
- you have a research permit authorizing you to stay for periods of more than 6 months,
- · you are under international protection or are stateless,
- you have a Blue Card,
- · you have a permit for self-employment,
- · you are a worker from Algeria, Morocco or Tunisia.

If you do not have the required residence permit

Send your application anyways by registered letter or certified email to the INPS office for your area, specifying the type of your residence permit

#### and

contact a Citizens Advice Bureau (patronato), trade unions or organizations such as ASGI to learn more about your rights and evaluate the possibility of taking legal action.
